



DuPage Water Commission Attends Argonne National Laboratory for Earth Day

On Thursday, April 21st, 2011, DuPage Water Commission Water Preservation Group Member Jenessa Nesbitt was in attendance as an exhibitor for Earth Day for Argonne National Laboratory employees. The display from the Commission as well as other Earth-friendly displays was set up on the way into the lunch area so the Argonne employees could peruse through them on the way to lunch.

Even though this is an annual event and the same items were given away last year, around 50 informational pamphlets about toilet leaks, lawncare, indoor/outdoor water use, and a water quiz were handed out; about 150 5-minute shower timers; 200 rain gauges; and 80 toilet leak detection tablets were distributed. Many people were excited to see rain gauges and shower timers were developed and thought that these products were great ways to save water.
